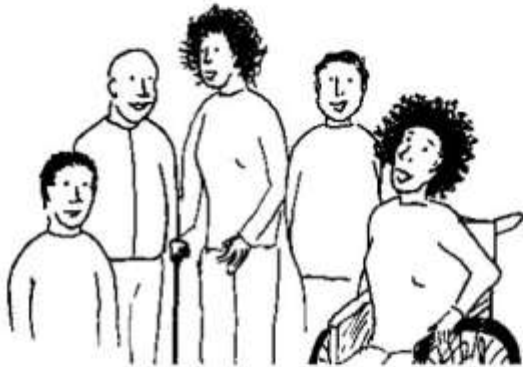

The Meeting

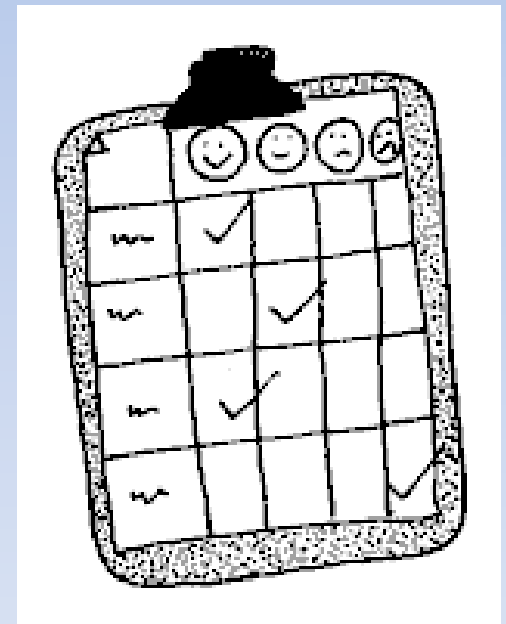
Janet Wright came to talk to us about the role of Co-Chair of the Partnership Board.
